

Dear Community Members,

We Moved! Our office and operations center are now located at 549A Castro Street. This is great news for the Community Benefit District and for the Castro. Having our operations center on Castro St. means we are able to get out and clean the heart of the business district right away! You can see our clean team members cleaning Castro Street by 6:30 a.m. Our goal is to have Castro, 18th Streets and Harvey Milk Plaza clean by the time people start heading to work in the morning.

The Castro Community Benefit District is responsible for cleaning and monitoring 3 miles of sidewalk 7 days a week. What do we do?

- Sweep the sidewalk daily from property line to curb line
- Abate graffiti on public and private property (property owners sign our graffiti waiver)
- Power wash the sidewalk for each parcel in the district on a regular schedule
- Power wash hazardous waste and other debris on the sidewalk
- · Power wash graffiti off the sidewalk
- Report unsafe/hazardous situations to 911/311

- Walk the district providing an added sense of vibrancy
- Greet passersby and visitors
- Deescalate negative street behavior
- Outreach to unhoused and connect them to city services
- Distribute No Trespassing signs (Do you need one? email: info@castrocbd.org)
- Operate a dispatch number to report any of the above to the CBD: 415-471-7563

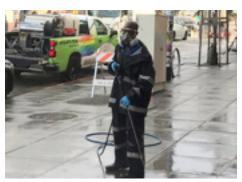

What is Castro Cares?

Castro Cares is the Castro Community Benefit District's program promoting public safety and outreach to the unhoused in the district. The program includes: 4 Full-Time unarmed Community Ambassadors walking the district 12 hours a day, 7 days a week. These community ambassadors:

- Respond to calls for service (415-471-7536)
- Act as an extra set of eyes and ears, creating a sense of safety in the neighborhood
- · Assist merchants with negative street behavior challenges
- · Check on unhoused
- Connect unhoused to city services

The 4 full time Community Ambassadors are not funded with assessment dollars, rather, they are funded through a city grant.

Assessments

Property Assessment Method

The levy and collection of annual assessments upon property within the Castro Community Benefit District area provides the primary funding source for the improvements, maintenance, and activities carried out by the Castro Community Benefit District. Funding for the district is proportionally shared by property owners, who are self-assessed to supplement services provided by the City.

These annual assessments are based on the following variables:

- Linear (sidewalk) frontage
- · Type of land use
- Lot square footage
- Location (zone)
- Building square footage

Each property owner's assessment is calculated according to the special benefit received from the services provided by the Castro Community Benefit District. Accordingly, each property is assessed with their proportional special benefit based upon the various property characteristics and land use type compared to other properties within the district.

The charts to the right provide a summary of the assessment rate calculations for Zone 1, Zone 2 and Zone 3 (see map). For more information on assessment calculations, please refer to the Castro CBD's Management Plan.

Assessment Increases

Assessment rates may increase by up to 5% per year or by the change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward area for February, whichever is less. The determination of annual adjustments in assessments rates will be subject to the approval of the Castro CBD Board of Directors.
